Electronics Recycling

Did you get a new gadget this Christmas, wondering what to do with your old one? January can be a big month for local waste haulers as folks are discarding their old electronics for the newest model. The most important thing to remember is that these items can contain potentially hazardous materials such as heavy metals and other materials that require special handling.

Sometimes you can sell these items to online or local firms that will refurbish and resell them, but if not, residents can have their Household Hazardous Waste and E-Waste collected right from their front door. Waste Management provides an "At Your Door Special Collection Service" to dispose of household hazardous waste (HHW), and e-waste (electronic waste such as TV's, computer monitors, and consumer electronics with circuit boards). Operating Sprinkler Systems in Cold Weather

It's important to remember that not only is operating a sprinkler system during freezing temperatures unsafe and potentially damaging to your system, it's also against the law.

Municipal Ordinance states that it is unlawful for any person or organization to operate a sprinkler system or permit water to run-off from a sprinkler onto streets or sidewalks if the temperatures are at or below freezing (32°F or 0°C). (Ord # 2007-1157)

This is not only a nuisance, it may also create a hazardous situation for you and your fellow citizens, so remember to include your sprinkler system in your pre-freeze preparations.
