

Municipal Officer Election

The City of Coppel has scheduled a Municipal Officers Election for Saturday, May 10, 2014. Candidate positions on the ballot are Places 1, 3, 5, and 7. Elected officers will serve three-year terms.

Citizens interested in running for a position must file an application sometime between Wednesday, January 29, and Friday, February 28. Candidate packets are available for pickup in the City Secretary's office at Town Center, 255 Parkway Blvd., Monday through Friday, 8 AM - 5 PM.

Qualifications for the candidates filing for an elected office include: Must be a qualified voter, candidate must be a resident of Coppel for at least 12 months preceding the date of the election, the candidate may not be in arrears in the payment of any taxes or other liabilities due the City.

You Can Prevent Storm Water Pollution

If you change the oil in your car, don't dump it on the ground or in the storm drain; dispose of it properly at an oil recycling center.

Check your car, boat and/or motorcycle for leaks. Clean up spilled fluids with an absorbent material, don't rinse the spills into the storm drain.

Crisis Communication

Communication before, during and after a crisis is critical. The City has a multitude of communication avenues that can be used for different situations and for different levels of preparedness or a request for action during an event. We need your help. Please sign up for at least two of the communication methods listed to ensure you receive important messages.

Preparedness Message Delivery; i.e., traffic disruption, event cancellation

ConnectCTY-Sign up via the City website at coppelltx.gov using the icon on the front page. A primary phone number MUST be added for the data to be accepted. Please consider adding a SMS capable phone number and an email address for less invasive contact. This system is ideal

for sending messages encouraging preparation well before an event occurs. This system is not fast enough to send messages about severe weather WARNINGS.

CoppellClips-Email used for preparedness state. Sign up for *CoppellClips* by accessing the City's website at coppelltx.gov and clicking on the *MyCoppell* icon. Provide an email address and you'll begin receiving this electronic newsletter and special mailings addressing events you may need to be prepared for.

Immediate Warnings/Action Needed Message Delivery: Weather WARNINGS, traffic incidents/detours

Twitter (@coppellem), *Facebook* (City-of-Coppell-TX) - Capable of sending out quick, short messages about situation and how to respond. Follow us on *Twitter*, become a Fan on *Facebook* and tie your account into your cell phone for quick easy access.

All Clear Messages: Event has passed. *Twitter* and *Facebook*.

Are you Registered to Vote?

With congressional midterms and local elections on the horizon, now is the time to make sure that you are registered to vote in Coppell. In order to cast your vote, you must be a registered voter in the county in which you live (the majority of Coppell is in Dallas County, but some portions of northern Coppell are in Denton County). Voter registration cards must be postmarked and sent to the proper county office 30 days prior to any election day.

You can register to vote by visiting votetexas.org and filling out a voter registration application online, printing it and mailing it to the voter registrar in your county of residence. You are not registered until you have filled out the online application, printed it, AND mailed it to your local County Voter Registrar. This online tool will help you fill out the necessary information, and provide you with the mailing address for your local County Voter Registrar based on the information you provide.

You may also find preprinted voter registration cards at the William T. Cozby Public Library, 177 N. Hartz. Pick one up, fill it out, and drop it in the mail.
