

StreetWISE - Cars, Bicycles, and Joggers

Cars, bicycles, and joggers often share the roadway. The Texas Transportation Code allows bicycles to operate on the street but cyclists must follow ALL traffic laws such as stop signs, signaling turns, etc. Joggers are not allowed in the street where a sidewalk is provided. Motorists must look carefully for bicyclists before turning right, merging into bicycle lanes, and opening doors next to moving traffic. If you see a hazardous situation call the police non-emergency line 972-304-3610, or if it is a life threatening emergency, call 9-1-1.
