



Illegal Signs Pay You

The **I SPY** program is a partnership between the City of Coppell and Coppell-based non-profit organizations. These organizations patrol the City on weekends and remove illegal temporary signage in the public right of way. Groups must be registered and scheduled through the City of Coppell Building Inspections Department. The City of Coppell will pay a participating non-profit organization \$150 per weekend for their service.

If your non-profit organization is interested in partnering with the City to earn some money and help keep Coppell beautiful, please visit the Building Inspections Department at 265 E. Parkway Blvd. to apply. All individuals (or legal guardians of minors) who participate in the program must register and sign Release & Hold Harmless Agreements before your organization's application can be approved. Organizations must designate one or more responsible individuals to attend a training session with the City. Once your organization is approved, weekend scheduling is performed by Building Inspections.



Requests for scheduling must be submitted no later than the 15th of any month for the weekends in the following month. For example, requests to be scheduled for weekends in February must be submitted no later than January 15th. If multiple organizations are requesting to be scheduled, then no single organization can be scheduled for more than two consecutive weekends. The City will make every effort to schedule weekend work in a fair and equitable manner.

SAFETY is the City's top priority:

- Minors must always be with an adult.
- Always wear the reflective safety vest supplied by the City.
- Always pull into a parking lot or side street before exiting the vehicle.
- Always use crosswalks.
