Entry Guidelines

1. All participants must be in grades 3 through 7.
2. Entries may be submitted as an original writing/poem, artwork, or video on the theme "Why I'm excited for my public library to reopen in its brand new space":
 - a. Writings must be a poem, or an essay no longer than 500 words in length.
 - b. Original artwork must be no larger than 8 1/2" by 11".
 - c. Videos must be no longer than 2 minutes.
3. One entry per person.

Submission Guidelines

1. Entries must be emailed to CozbyPrograms@coppelltx.gov no later than midnight on Sunday, October 16 with the following:
 - a. Subject Heading: Mr. Lemoncello
 - b. Two Attachments: Submission file (writing, scanned artwork, video) AND completed entry form (PDF file).
 - c. Body of Email: Entrant's full name and contact number or email.
2. Any submissions without a completed entry form will not be eligible to win until one is obtained.

Entry Displays & Judging

1. Submissions will be judged by Library Staff based upon originality and theme.
2. Any stories that are inappropriate for all audiences will be automatically disqualified and not judged. All decisions are final.
3. Entries will be displayed during Grand Opening sneak peek events, on Facebook and Twitter, and the Grand Opening Celebration throughout the month of November.
4. Selected winners will be issued an invitation to our Mr. Lemoncello After-Hours event on Saturday, November 12.
