**WHEREAS**, this obligation extends not only to today's caretakers but also to the future generations of caretakers who will inherit our planet from us; and


**WHEREAS**, the City of Coppel is committed to building on this success and dedicated to inspiring global action through local activism and global environmental consciousness through local awareness.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I Karen Selbo Hunt, Mayor of the City of Coppel, do hereby proclaim April 22, 2016 as


### "EARTH DAY"
