To request a Ballot by Mail, eligible voters can call **214.819.6300** or **214.819.6359** or send an “informal application” by mail, fax **214.819.6301** or email to [EVAPPLICATIONS@DALLASCOUNTY.ORG](mailto:EVAPPLICATIONS@DALLASCOUNTY.ORG) no later than **Friday, October 23, 2015**.

**Ballot by Mail applications must provide a mailing address that is outside of county of residence and the dates beginning and ending of receiving mail at this out of county address.**

**NEW LAW:** 2015 Legislative Session HB 1927 now provides that a voter may deliver their carrier envelope containing their marked ballot in person on election day from 7:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. to the early voting clerk at Dallas County Elections. The voter must provide Photo ID upon delivery of the carrier envelope.
