What are the minimum qualifications to apply for Police Officer with the City Of Coppell?

- High School Diploma or Equivalent with minimum of 30 college credit hours (College Degree Preferred)
- Valid State Of Texas Driver's License (Or the ability to obtain one)
- Good Driving Record
- T.C.O.L.E. Basic Peace Officer Certification Preferred, but not necessary

What does the hiring process entail?

- Complete preliminary application
- Written Exam
- Physical Fitness Test
- Personal History Statement
- Thorough Background Investigation
- Oral Panel Interview
- Conditional Offer of Employment
- Pre-Employment Polygraph
- Pre-Employment Psychological Exam

What shifts do patrol officer's work?

Our patrol officers work 12 hour shifts. We have two day shifts and two night shifts. They are from 6:00am-6:00pm and 6:00pm-6:00am. We also have a wide variety of specialized positions that work various hours and 5 day work weeks.

What days off do patrol officers have?

Patrol officers have 3 days off one week and 4 days off the next week, with one of their shifts being an eight hour day.
