

Request for Deferred Disposition

Deferred Disposition is an option you may be able to request to keep a violation off your driving record. This option is available for most offenses. You must pay a fine and court costs on the day the deferred disposition is granted. Please call the court to obtain the total amount due. You will be placed on a probationary period, usually 90 days, and you must not receive another citation during that time. Other conditions may be imposed that you will be made aware of, if applicable.

If the case is a traffic violation and you are under the age of 25, you must complete a driving safety course as a condition of deferred disposition. In addition, if you hold a provisional driver's license (under 18), an examination by the Department of Public Safety is required as a condition of deferred disposition.

Upon successful completion of the deferred period and timely return of all required documents, the violation will be dismissed.

If approved, a copy of the order deferring disposition will be mailed to the address provided below. The order will set out all the conditions of deferred disposition and give you the information necessary to report your compliance. If you do not receive this paperwork within 15 days, you must contact the court.
